Thank you for the information you submitted on November 8, 2010 regarding your request to be recognized as eligible to receive tax deductible contributions. We have made it part of your file.

After reviewing your submitted information, your organization meets the criteria required to receive tax deductible contributions under IRC sections 170(c)(3) and 2522(a)(4). Contributions made to your organization are tax deductible to their donors starting November 8, 2010, the date you submitted your request. Contributions will continue being tax deductible as long as your organization's membership consists of 90% war veterans. Contributions made to your organization prior to November 8, 2010 are not tax deductible.


Since your exempt status was not under consideration, you continue to be classified as an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(19) of the Code.
